Chairman Thomas Calcei called the meeting to order at 8:00 PM. Present were Board Members Jared Phillip, Thomas Calcei, Jeff Eldreth, and Lori Calcei, Fiscal Officer.

FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT

Fire Chief Robert Rasnick reported that the Fire Department had (5) Continuing Ed Classes and the following (72) Calls during the month of: February

(58) EMS Calls, (1) Vehicle Accident Call, (9) Fire Response Calls & (4) Mutual Aid Calls

STATE OF OHIO EMS PROVIDER OF THE YEAR

The Fire Department has the honor of having the State of Ohio EMS provider of the year 2018 on our roster. Captain Robert L Dudley, a 48-year veteran of our fire department was awarded this honor in Columbus.

ISO RATING

The Fire Department received our ISO rating. It is a class 4. They are working towards getting a better rating for structures more than 1000 feet from a recognized water source.

BWC GRANT

The Fire Department received a BWC grant for new firefighter gloves. The total cost of the project is \$4752.00. BWC will fund \$3960 of this amount leaving us with the cost of \$792.

SIGNS

Mr. Phillip provided the estimate for the new Township signs; it was then moved by Mr. Phillip and seconded by Mr. Eldreth for a PO to Graphic Detail Inc. for \$5000.00.

A resident complained about the condition of the yard at 1868 Waterloo Rd. She is very disappointed that we cannot do anything about this mowing problem. She asked the Trustees to come up with a plan. The Trustees told her that at this time we could not mow the property. Mr. Calcei is checking with Chris Meduri to see if there is anything, we can do anything about this situation.

ROAD REPORT

Mr. Eldreth informed us of the following:

1. Ed Hanna last day will be July 13.
2. We are almost done mowing the side of the roads.
3. The crack sealing is almost done.
4. We are working on the Palm Rd issue. We may need to close the road on Friday. Mr. Eldreth will let the Fire department know if we close it.
5. There are trees in the cemetery that quickly needed to be cut done. Since this was an emergency, we hired Kuntzman to cut down the tree we will ask for a PO then and now at next meeting.
6. There is a dispute between neighbors that live on Mishler and Manning over spraying the fields. Mr. Phillip told them we do not get involved in neighborhood dispute.
7. Mr. Eldreth is still looking into building a new salt shed.

H LULI PALM ROAD WORK (PO)

It was moved by Mr. Eldreth and seconded Phillip to approve a Po for \$8000 to H Luli to perform work on Palm Rd.

RESIDENT COMMENTS AND CONCERNS

1. The Trustees were questioned about what is happening with Wingfoot Lake question. We responded that we are still planning to put a marker up to mark the elevation of the water and that Portage County may be able to do the survey for us. Resident is concerned about water coming up Bolender.
2. Mr. Albertoni complained about his road. He stated that it was crack sealed but never chip and sealed. Mr. Eldreth informed him that we had to put our roadwork on hold for a couple of years because of the lawsuit. Mr. Albertoni also complained about the so-called can man on Valley Crests. There has never been any other complaints about him from neighbors per the Trustees. He was also upset because he thought he was removed from TIRC committee, but no he was not removed from the committee; he just missed the last meeting and missed getting his picture taken.
3. Mr. Yeargin gave us a site plan map for the old West Country Club property in Mogadore that shows the 9.43 acres that are in Suffield are no longer going to be estate homes. Ryan Homes is going to build apartment townhouses, condominium and homes on this property. Mr. Yeargin is afraid that the property could be annexed.
